On the Lighter Side - "Mint Julep Cocktail"

The official drink of the Kentucky Derby

What You'll Need:

- 1 teaspoon sugar
- 1 teaspoon water
- 8 fresh mint leaves, plus sprigs for garnish
- 1 cup crushed ice
- 2 2/3 ounces (1/3 cup) bourbon

Makes 1 drink

- Stir together sugar and water in a mint julep cup (or 8-ounce glass) until sugar dissolves.
- 2. Add mint, muddle gently using a muddler or a wooden spoon.
- 3. Fill with crushed ice, and add bourbon.
- 4. Stir until outside of cup is frosted. Garnish with mint sprigs.
