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Grills - New Policy effective 11/30/2018

As previously communicated, **all open-flame cooking devices** (gas & charcoal grills) are prohibited from decks and all of Monmouth Way's common areas, effective November 30, 2018.

The use of electric grills on your deck is allowed.

A new committee, which included 3 residents and 3 board members, was created to discuss possible options for specific grilling areas to be constructed and located in certain common areas. The committee met on September 10th and after considerable discussion they determined there were not any viable options. This determination was based on the fire code compliance, common areas policies, and any excessive cost to association.

Disposal of Gas Tanks

For folks needing to dispose of gas tanks associated with their gas grill - the Town of Halfmoon will accept them. Here are their instructions:

- Pick up a "permit" from the Town Clerk's office located at Halfmoon Town Hall. There is <u>no charge</u> for the permit.
- Bring the permit along with the gas tank to the Transfer Station located at the Town Garage on Route 146 across from the Sunoco station.
- Please note: the gas tank must be <u>empty</u>.

"Fall Social" Community Meeting

Dumpster "Do's & Don'ts!"

- When disposing of personal property, such as furniture, it **MUST be placed INSIDE of the dumpster**, and NOT on the side or behind it. Please also make sure to break down large boxes before placing in recycling bins.
- Please understand our garbage disposal company will not do this for you. Their trucks will only dispose of the contents that are contained inside of the dumpster. For large items, you may contact County Waste directly for pick-up and disposal. Tel: (518) 877-7007 or (888) 549-2783

Important note for contractors hired for remodeling: Please inform them that any large debris items must be removed by them & not placed in dumpsters. This has been a <u>major problem</u> recently - dumpsters have been overflowing and filled beyond capacity with debris - leaving other residents with no place in the dumpster for their trash. Please be respectful of this for your neighbor and our community's sake.

"Pumpkin Mousse Pie (made w/reduced fat pie crust)

Instructions

Ingredients

½ cup cold fat-free milk

pumpkin pie spice

1 package vanilla

flavor fat-free, sugar free instant pudding

1 tub (8 oz) reduced fat cool whip, thawed

1 tablespoon

1 cup canned pumpkin

- In large bowl whisk together milk and spice. Add pumpkin. Stir until combined. Add pudding mix. Beat with wire whisk for 1 ½ minutes. Stir in half of the whipped topping. Spread in crust.
- Top with remaining whipped topping.

Refrigerate at least 3 hours. Garnish as desired. Store in refrigerator.
