## Speeding.

#### Outdoor Water Spigots.

If you choose to turn the outside water on this year, please plan to be home to monitor the inside valve for leaking. If there is a leak, immediately shut valve and notify management of the leak.

#### Good Housekeeping.

Spray paint should NOT be used without a drop cloth behind and under all items. There are recent incidences of spray paint being used while items are leaning against trees. Both trees and lawn are also painted when this happens.

### Because you asked.

Question: I have mice in my unit. Am I responsible for calling someone to set traps/remove them or is the association responsible?

Answer: You are responsible. The wiring from the heat pumps to the building have been neglected and seems to be a conduit for mice to enter the building. The upkeep of sealing these cables is the responsibility of the homeowner; however, the Association is undertaking a one-time task of making sure all lines into the building are sealed. After these lines are sealed, you will once again be responsible for the upkeep of these lines.

Also, in addition to attracting birds, bird feeders will also attract squirrels, chipmunks, mice.
